Fruita **FARMERS MARKET**

Vendors must comply with all market requirements for the products they wish to sell

🍒 1 - A City of Fruita Business License must be acquired **BEFORE** market participation. License fees are to be paid directly to the City of Fruita at 325 E. Aspen Ave. 858-3663.

🍒 2 - Certified For Trade scales must be used for all items sold by weight.

🍒 3 - ALL Vendors must have a canopy or large umbrella for shade. For those who do not have their own canopy the market has a limited number of canopies for rent. Canopy rental is \$10 per day and canopies are rented on a first come/first served basis.

🍒 4 - Vendors are encouraged to use tent weights. Staking is not permitted!

🍒 5 - Vendor's selling non-food items are required to remit sales tax collected (7.9%). Food sold to be eaten on the premises and other goods are subject to sales tax. There is no sales tax on food for home consumption.

🍒 6 - Retail Food Establishment (RFE) license is **REQUIRED** to be on file with the Fruita Farmers Market for all prepared food items sold at the market.

🍒 7 - City of Fruita business license, necessary permits and certification should be prominently displayed.

🍒 8 - Each vendor is responsible for leaving their area neat and clean after the day's market.

🍒 9 - A high quality of produce is to be maintained.

🍒 10 - The Fruita Farmers Market assumes no responsibility for injury, theft, loss or damages incurred.
